Together, we are helping families find stability at home so that children can dream bigger, grow stronger, and flourish.

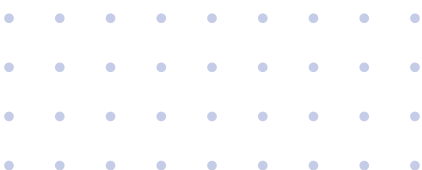

NATURE OF ACTIVITIES

Family Promise of Shenandoah County, Inc. (the Organization) is a non-profit, non-stock corporation located in Shenandoah County, Virginia. The Organization's support comes primarily from the general public and special events. The mission of FPSC is to transform the lives of children and families experiencing temporary homelessness by helping them find support services and safe, affordable, permanent housing in our community.

Family Promise opened in January of 2016 and welcomed the first family into shelter on February 3, 2016. Upon opening, church host sites provided volunteers who provided meals and sleeping accommodations for guest families. With the onset of the COVID-19 global pandemic, churches could no longer provide this hospitality. FPSC began leasing properties in Shenandoah County for use as non-congregate shelter.

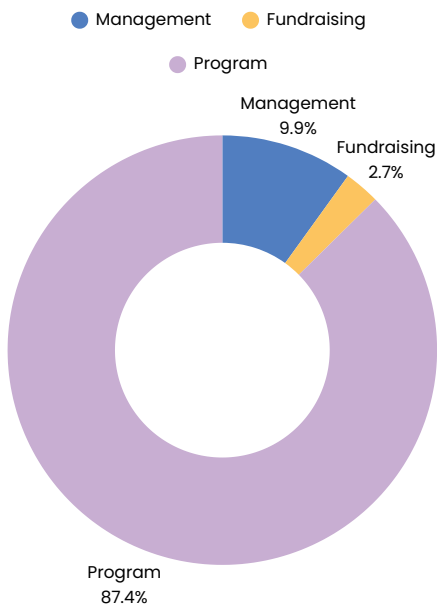
FPSC currently leases four apartments in a Scattered Sites Shelter Program model and one townhome in our Transitional Housing model. Guest families are sheltered in these spaces while receiving case management services. This includes goal setting, securing lucrative employment, budgeting, and good tenancy training. Through the Case Manager's contacts with both landlords and property managers, they work to secure affordable, permanent housing.

FPSC provides Stabilization services to former guests and low-income families. Providing food, supplies, transportation assistance, childcare payments, rent, and utility support helps these families remain housed.

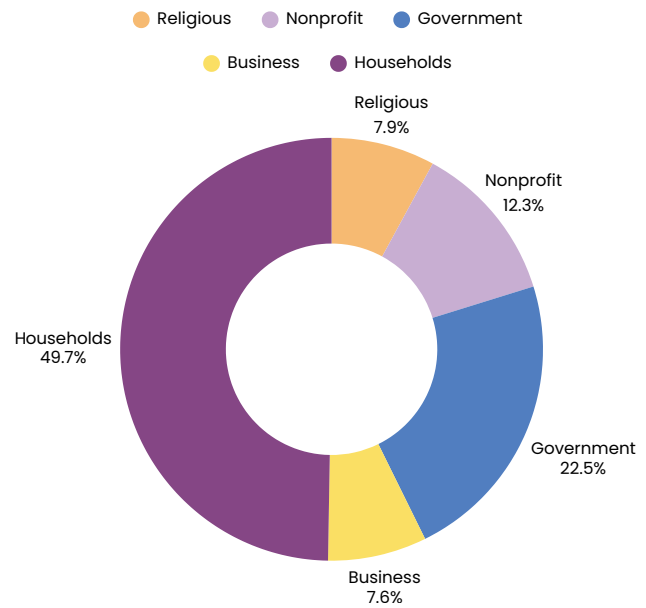
FPSC partners with many agencies in Shenandoah County and surrounding areas to help families secure and maintain permanent housing, sustainable employment, and other necessary skills and benefits from social service programs. Follow-up services and ongoing support are provided to each family to ensure long-term stability.

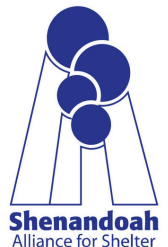
