Executive Director's Update

As we step into a new year, we pause to reflect on the remarkable year we've shared. Your generosity, time, and belief in our mission have made a tangible difference in the lives of the people and programs we serve. From volunteers who rolled up their sleeves to partners who amplified our impact, every contribution helped us reach new milestones and expand access to essential services.

Thanks to you, in 2025:

- Our four Core Programs alone served 166 families with 296 children.
- Together, we provided Thanksgiving and Christmas boxes to 45 families/105 children.
- Grant funds prevented eviction, and subsequent homelessness, for the families of nearly 100 Shenandoah County Public School Children.
- We hosted three record-setting community fundraising events, bringing together hundreds of neighbors.
- We secured partnerships that will deepen our impact for years to come.

We are deeply grateful for your trust and for the opportunity to collaborate. Together, we are strengthening our mission to end family homelessness in Shenandoah County. Case Manager's Corner

A few weeks before Christmas, I received a call from a graduate of our shelter program. She had been doing well but had recently faced some unexpected expenses and was short on rent. She didn't want to call and ask for help — she said she wasn't sure what else to do. She'd pulled all of her money together but still couldn't make ends meet. There was nothing left for food, and she couldn't afford a Christmas gift for her daughter. Family Promise was able to help. As part of our Stabilization program, we provided groceries and financial assistance for rent and utilities.

Just a few days later, a local business owner reached out to us wanting to provide Christmas for a family in need. I immediately thought of this family and shared a bit of their story. He was happy to assist them, and we collaborated to create a Christmas list for both family members!

Just before Christmas, they met at our office to deliver the gifts. The family car was filled with presents for both mom and daughter. As goodbyes were being said, she was also given a very generous gift card. There was not a dry eye as we all witnessed the amazing generosity of our community and were reminded of the true spirit of Christmas!
